

## JULY 16-18, 2020 COVID-19 RULES

- Horse show is closed to spectators.
- Online entering is required at <a href="www.horseshowsonline.com">www.horseshowsonline.com</a>. Changes accepted at the show and may be called/texted/emailed to Liz Holmes @ 919-672-3741 or lizholmes1957@gmail.com.
- Trainers, staff, and exhibitors with each barn will complete and sign "Rider COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire and Waiver" prior to or immediately upon arrival on the show grounds. Such documents are to remain in the secure care of the Show Office.
- Non-essential people are discouraged from attending the show.
- Only officials allowed in the Show Office. Registration will be online with changes to be by text only. If Show Secretary deems a face-to-face meeting necessary, it will be by appointment only.
- Hand sanitation tables will be located at the in/out gate, at registration desk, warm up area, and center ring.
   YOU MUST SANITIZE YOUR HANDS EACH TIME YOU APPROACH THE RAIL FROM THE WARMUP AREA AND/OR REGISTRATION DESK.
   Please bring hand sanitizer with >60% alcohol to the show with you.
- Masks are required when on the showgrounds and encouraged when distancing is not possible. Masks are not required when on a horse.
- Warmup area will be limited to the participants in next 2 classes and will be limited in number. We will provide ample time and/or holds between classes as needed.
- Only TWO attendants per entry in the warmup area.
- Trainer/coach/attendants must be spaced 6 feet apart around the rail. <u>STAY IN YOUR SPOT FOR THE DURATION OF THE CLASS</u>. Avoid touching the rail.
- Winning trainer/header will pick up ribbon/award as they pass center ring to the presentation area. 2<sup>nd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> ribbons may be picked up at the ribbon table outside of the ring.
- Proper distancing must be maintained in the barn areas. Non-essential people are discouraged from attending the show. Dogs are NOT permitted around the ring or warmup and must be leashed elsewhere.
- Each person must be accountable for themselves and for reminding others if improper distancing or behavior is observed. Look out for each other.
- Food Truck: Orders will be called or texted in for pickup. Social distancing will be required for picking up food if unable to text order.

## **ACADEMY – IN ADDITION TO THE RULES ABOVE:**

- Non-essential people are discouraged from attending the show.
- Riders should arrive ready to show to avoid dressing in the bathroom.
- Classes will run per age group with Equitation & Showmanship classes back-to-back for that age group.
- Riders will remain in the ring for both classes. Winning instructor will pick up award in center ring on way to
  presentation area. Places 2 6 will remain in the lineup as the class is tied and pick up ribbons for both classes at the
  ribbon table after the 2<sup>nd</sup> class. Handlers are welcome to be with riders in the lineup. Out gate will be opened as 2<sup>nd</sup>
  class is tied.
- Instructor, assistant, and rider ONLY in the warmup ring.
- ONLY THE NEXT AGE GROUP ALLOWED IN THE WARMUP AREA. Your age group will be called to the warmup area when the previous group enters the ring. Time will be provided between age groups as needed.
- When riders complete their 2 classes, they will exit the warmup area and, preferably, the showgrounds to help support limited capacity.
